Tuesday, Mar 27 2018 Amman Crowne Plaza

On arrival in Amman you will be met and transferred to your hotel.

Wednesday, Mar 28 2018 Petra Movenpick Resort Petra Breakfast and Dinner

This morning set off to meet the group coming from Israel. Your first stop will be the baptism site of Jesus Christ. For the past several years, the Jordanian Department of Antiquities has systematically surveyed and partially excavated a series of ancient sites that collectively represent one of the most important archaeological discoveries in modem Jordan — the settlement and region of Bethany (or Bethabra), where John the Baptist lived and baptized.

Continue to Mt. Nebo, the mountain where Moses was allowed to see the Holy Land... and not allowed to enter it. Nowadays the mountain is a memorial site. Here you can find the "Church of Moses", built by the first Christians. Ever since the first days of Christianity this mountain has been a holy place and a destination for pilgrimage. Like Moses, you can have a great view over Jordan, the Dead Sea and Israel. When the weather is clear, you should even be able to see Jerusalem, which is about 60 kilometres away.

Finally visit Madaba, known as the 'City of Mosaics' for its wealth of beautiful Byzantine mosaics; it is one of the most memorable places in the holy land; it is located south of Amman. 'The City of Mosaics offers many sites to explore. Amongst them, the chief attraction – in the contemporary Greek Orthodox church of St. George – is a wonderfully vivid, 6th century Byzantine mosaic map showing Jerusalem and other holy sites.

At end of the day you will arrive in Petra.

Located directly at the entrance to the historical Nabatean city of Petra, the luxurious Movenpick Resort Petra is certainly one of the most notable hotels in the Middle East. The resort is renowned for its intricate Arabesque interior design, and collection of antiques and artwork. Boasting 183 rooms and suites, seven restaurants, lounges, bars, attractive roof garden, library and gift shop, the resort also offers a wellness center with outdoor swimming pool, steam bath and gymnasium.

You have the full day to explore Petra in-depth. As the hidden valley opens before you, you will see the Nabatean "Rose Red City – half as old as time." Marvel at the incredible multi-hued sandstone rock coloring, tombs, temples and the amphitheater. Sturdy footwear is recommended for normally fit persons who choose to climb the sides of the valley for a closer look. Today's tour involves approximately four hours on your feet.

This evening return to Petra for a special visit to see the remains of the treasury and the siq by candlelight.



Friday, Mar 30 2018 Wadi Rum Wadi Rum Bedouin Camp Breakfast and Dinner

Your morning begins with a visit to Siq al Barid ("Little Petra"), the northern customs outpost for the Nabatean capital.

Continue south to Wadi Rum. You will not visit the tourist village of Wadi Rum at the end of a blacktop through the desert. Rather transfer to four wheel drive vehicles with Bedouin drivers and set off over the dunes to visit ancient rock carvings, view the Seven Pillars of Wisdom, view Lawrence's Jail, the remains of a partly closed off wadi and descend to the flat plain. Cross the old railway immortalized by Lawrence of Arabia in his campaign to successfully drive the Turks from Agaba in the early part of the 20th century.

Your accommodation this evening is in a private Bedouin tent. The camp is quiet and secluded from the Rum village and tourist population, surrounded by massive rock formations, rust-colored sunsets and ancient sands. Spend a peaceful evening under the endless desert sky in a luxury Bedouin tent. Though you will be occupying an isolated location with picturesque views of the vast Wadi Rum, your stay is not without comforts. Portable restroom and shower facilities are available for your use. Gourmet dinner featuring local cuisine is served in your intimate dining area with mineral water, juices, teas and local adult beverages. Relax on luxurious cushions and rugs of traditional Bedouin low seating and retire to an elegant bedroom complete with bed and end table furnishings. Torches, lanterns and candles throughout your camp site make for an even more intimate feel and complete your true Jordanian experience.



Saturday, Mar 31 2018 Amman Crowne Plaza Amman Breakfast

This morning we'll head to the Greco-Roman city of Jerash. Jerash is a fascinating, ancient city that holds as much attraction for visitors as the city of Petra. Jerash has a long line of human occupation and at this site, in the hills of Gilead, findings from Neolithic, Greek, Roman, Byzantine and Umayyad times have all been discovered. The Golden Age for this ancient city though, arrived under the Roman rule.

Arrive in Amman and check into your hotel.

Overlooking the white city of Amman, the stunningly situated Crowne Plaza Amman hotel is in close proximity and within walking distance to International fast food restaurants, main shopping area of Sweifiyeh, as well as the popular Gold Souk of Um Utheina and only 10 minutes from Amman's Citadel, Roman Theater and Souq Jara.

At the time advised you will be transferred to the Amman Airport and assisted with boarding your flight home or on to Egypt.

Sunday, Apr 01 2018 Cairo Conrad Cairo Breakfast

On arrival in Cairo, you will be met by a Ker & Downey representative and assisted through customs and immigration. Meet your driver and transfer to the Conrad Cairo.

The Conrad Hilton Cairo is located in the heart of downtown Cairo, overlooking the River Nile and close to Cairo attractions, including the magnificent Egyptian Pyramids, the Sphinx, and Cairo commercial districts.

Monday, Apr 02 2018 Nile River Sonesta St. George I Breakfast and Dinner

Transfer to the Cairo Airport and board a flight to Luxor. On arrival you will be transferred to the port to board your cruise.

Luxor stands where ancient Thebes, the "City of the Thousand Gates," once stood. Luxor, which means "the Palaces" in Arabic, is true to its name with a great number of magnificent temples and tombs. In an unforgettable excursion, you will visit the Luxor Temple, which was built by the two great pharaohs, Amenhotep III and Ramses II. After touring the temple, you will travel along an avenue of ram-headed Sphinxes, extending for about two miles, which link Luxor Temple with Karnak Temple, the center of worship in ancient Egypt. No site in the world makes a more overwhelming and lasting impression than this "Temple of all Temples."

Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Cross the Nile from Luxor where you will visit the Valley of the Kings which includes the tombs of the Thebian rulers. Next, tour the mortuary temple of Hatshepsut, the only woman pharaoh to reign in ancient Egypt (in the new Kingdom). Her temple, with its impressive architecture, is traditionally associated with Hathor, the goddess of love and joy. It was formerly surrounded by tropical gardens with plants imported from Somali land. The boat will sail to Esna then you will board it again from Esna.

Wednesday, Apr 04 2018 Nile River Sonesta St. George I Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Sail to Edfu, which lies 70 miles south of Luxor and is the site of one of the greatest and best preserved temples of ancient Egypt, the Horus Temple. The temple, completed during the Ptolemic age (305-30 B.C.), was dedicated to Horus and provides a wealth of information through its inscriptions, which describe the founding and construction methods of similar temples, as well as daily rituals and myths of ancient times.

Sail onward to Kom Ombo, 27 miles north of Aswan, which, since earliest times, has received visitors who have traveled through the Libyan and Arabian deserts from Sudan caravan routes. The town of Ombos gained administrative importance during the Ptolemic age as it protected the southern border of Egypt and in the Roman period was a military station. The temple has a double sanctuary and is dedicated to two divinities: Haroeris (Horus the Elder) and Sobek (the Crocodile God).

Sail to Aswan, Egypt's smallest governorate. Aswan was the country's premier winter resort from 910 to 24 BC, offering natural beauty, a relaxed and pleasant atmosphere and a warm, dry climate. Visit the Aswan High Dam. The old dam was built by Sir W. Wilcock on behalf of the British authorities in 1898. It was constructed from granite quarried in the Aswan area and the official opening took place in 1902. In the 1960's, a new dam was built by the Egyptian government. Also in Aswan, visit the unfinished obelisk which gives us a great deal of information about how granite obelisks were carved in ancient times. The existence of granite in the Aswan area was of particular interest to the ancient pharaohs since it provided them with a ready source of material for their building projects. Take a short boat ride to the Greco-Roman temples of Philae, re-sited on the island of Agilkia, now situated between the High Dam and the "old" dam. Philae is the sacred complex of monuments built for the cult of Isis and Osiris. Philae was built under the Ptolemies and finished in Roman times.

Enjoy lunch on board the cruise before your afternoon excursion. For this delightful excursion, you will sail by felucca (Egyptian-style sail boat), to the small granite island called Kitchener of the Botanical island. You will also visit Elephantine Island.

Friday, Apr 06 2018 Cairo Conrad Cairo Breakfast


This morning disembark in Aswan and meet your driver for your transfer to the Aswan Airport.

Optional:

Board a flight to Abu Simbel. You will visit the magnificent rock- hewn temples of Ramesses II that of his Queen Nefertari. They were moved about 40 years ago, 200 feet above their original site, now inundated by Lake Nasser and re-housed in an artificial mountain which successfully re-creates their original setting.

After the tour, return to Aswan and connect on to Cairo.

In the evening, browse the Khan el Khalili Bazaar.



Saturday, Apr 07 2018 Cairo Conrad Cairo Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

This morning, enjoy breakfast at your hotel. Meet your private Egyptologist and set off on your hafl day tour to the Giza Plateau.

First stop is one of the Seven Wonders of the World, namely the Great Pyramid and the Sphinx on the Giza Plateau. You will see The Great Pyramid from inside as well as visit the Solar Boat Museum. (Entrance to the Great Pyramid is controlled on site and subject to availability.)

After lunch at a local restaurant, enjoy a fabulous tour of Cairo's history and culture. You will explore the Egyptian Museum of Antiquities. Here, one could find themselves mesmerized for hours in this vast treasure trove of rare Egyptian pieces of art, history and symbols. View the golden coffin and mask of King Tut along with many other artifacts from his tomb. Depending on the touring schedule of the exhibit, the museum maintains a fabulous assortment of exhibits at all time.

This evening enjoy dinner with an Egyptian Christian family in their home.
